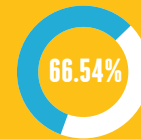
HISPANIC UNEMPLOYMENT REMAINS ABOVE THE NATIONAL LEVEL

NATIONAL: 4.2%

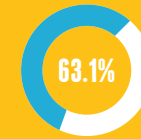


HISPANICS REMAIN EAGER TO WORK
